Dear friends,

Thank you for your support and interest in the work of Centre Medical Evangelique (CME) in the DRC. It is much appreciated.

Medical work:

The 3 CME hospitals cared for 80,000 patients in 2022, with 31,000 consultations, 11,000 hospitalisations, and 30,000 receiving primary health care. 9,400 people were operated upon. CME provides 403 beds in total over the 3 sites shown below: Bunia 117, Beni/Sose 114 and Nyankunde 172.





The pictures below show the corridor between the wards at Nyankunde, the children's ward and two children in that ward. We send funds to CME to help pay the medical costs of the poorest of the patients to try to ensure CME maintains its goal of not turning anyone away. With our support, 136 patients at Nyankunde and 110 at Beni/Sose received financial help across all ages and sexes. Sadly, due to increased terrorist attacks in the Beni area, the hospital at Sose, located in a village outside Beni, is currently closed and CME has been forced to move its work into Beni town centre. On the other hand, improved security at Nyankunde has meant many more people, staff and patients returning.





Elections and insecurity:

As mentioned last letter, the north-eastern part of the DRC, where CME functions, is still very insecure through the activities of the terrorist group, ADF. A recent attack on a Ugandan school by the ADF hit UK news. On a national level, tensions are mounting as presidential elections are planned for Dec 2023. For those of you who pray, please remember these difficult challenges for the country and CME staff.





Children's work:

<u>Nyankunde</u>: We were able to support another 141 orphans at Nyankunde who took their final school exams recently at a cost of £2,000. This photo on the left shows some of children in class. <u>Beni and Oicha</u>: We are really pleased that we have been able to fund the full £42,000 cost of providing the schooling and food for 317 orphaned children in the program. Thank you again to those of you who've been able to help with this. The schools have recently finished for the year and the payment of school fees and distribution of food has gone well (below right).
