

Welcome to our first newsletter of 2018. This will be a brief update on our work but also include important information about how we will be communicating with you and looking after your data under the new data protection rules (GDPR).


### Orphans

At Oicha, we are pleased to let you know that after some early delays in starting the schools due to insecurity, the 315 children we support have now been at school for 6 months and the end of the school year is approaching. The project has proceeded as planned with the children being homed by foster families who we supply with enough rice, beans, milk and bread for a daily meal. The project also provides them monthly with bars of soap. Through your generous support, we have also been able to pay the school fees for the children as well as provide school uniforms, bags and some basic notebooks. We are expecting an updated video from Oicha soon which we look forward to sharing with you.

At Nyankunde, the schools we helped start several years ago now have 10,409 children attending with 265 teachers. We only provide funds for the orphans taking their final exams since the teachers are now mostly paid and the other childrens' fees are paid by their parents. This year, 178 orphans will take their finals at a cost of about £1,500.

### Security

At Nyankunde and Beni, there has been more stability in recent months. However, you may be aware that the President promised to hold elections this year but seems to be procrastinating again causing unrest in various parts of the country. This includes the north-east where CME operates.

It has been on our news that many displaced people have fled to Bunia where the third CME hospital is located. One report says there are over 200,000 Internally Displaced People there. They fled because of tribal conflict but one of our sources says that the government is stirring up these old disputes to create unrest and then an excuse not to hold the elections. If you pray, please remember this situation.
